Good parks include Hawick, Riding Mill, Wallington "train park", ... The scale of Lowther or Lilidorei is different, but the quality is worth striving for. Perhaps a school project to design something? Keep the metal climbing frame (it's still very popular, even though it's at least 50 years old), but have it laser-stripped and properly repainted with the sort of paint technology they've used on the Tyne Bridge (and Forth Bridge). Possibly controversial, but consider extending the playpark slightly? It's very popular, so extending might give a little more space. Here's a design thought: anyone remember the giant pencils at Eldon Square? These were seating and climbing structures all-in-one, simple and popular with kids, and I've not seen their like anywhere else:
