The following contract terms will apply. Tendering contractors should review and confirm these terms are acceptable before submitting their tender.

In the event of query, the tendering contractor should raise this as a tender clarification as per the tender document instructions.

In the event of objection, qualification or wish to propose alternative terms, the tendering contractor must highlight this within their tender offer.

- The Form of Contract is JCT Minor Works with Contractor's Design 2024 (MWD24).
 The contract is not supplemented by a Framework Agreement.
- 2. The Employer is The Horniman Public Museum and Public Park Trust, 100 London Rd, London SE23 3PQ.

They are not a construction industry scheme contractor for tax purposes.

- 3. The Location of the Works is at The Garden Toilets, Horniman Gardens, 100 London Rd, London SE23 3PQ.
- 4. The Works is Refurbishment of the Garden Toilet Block, comprising replacement of windows, replacement of all internal sanitaryware, cubicles, finishes, fixtures and fittings, associated plumbing, waste, mechanical and electrical work and exterior repointing.
- 5. The Works Commencement Date is 23rd February 2026.
- 6. The **Date for Completion** is **31**st **March 2026**.
- 7. The Contractor's Designed Portion is:
 - a. Final technical design of windows to meet the employer's requirements
 - b. Final technical design of plumbing and waste systems to meet the employer's requirements
 - c. Final technical design of electrical and mechanical systems to meet the employer's requirements
 - d. Final technical design of all containment, bracketry and fixings to meet the employer's requirements
 - e. The technical design of aspects within the scope as required to meet the Building Regulations.
- 8. The Contract Administrator is Dorian Burt of Dorian Burt Associates.

- 9. The CDM Principal Designer is The Horniman Public Museum and Public Park Trust.
- 10. The CDM Principal Contractor is the appointed contractor TBC.
- 11. The work is not CDM notifiable.
- 12. The Building Regulations Principal Designer is the appointed contractor TBC.
- 13. The Building Regulations Principal Contractor is the appointed contractor TBC.
- 14. The **scope of work** and **contractor's design responsibilities** are as detailed in the **tender** invitation document, the tender documents and tender drawings, ref's TBC.
- 15. The **pricing document** provided by the contractor is **the successful contractor's tender submission documents, ref's TBC**.
- 16. The contract is to be executed as a deed.
- 17. The first interim valuation date is 10th March and three-weekly thereafter TBC.
- 18. The valuation currency shall be GBP.
- 19. The base date shall be the date of tender submission.
- 20. Value fluctuation provisions do not apply.
- 21. Contract instructions, notices and communications shall be by email.
- 22. The Rectification Period is Twelve months.
- 23. **Retention** is held at **5% on interim payments** and **2.5% on practical completion**, with the remainder released at expiry of defects period if defects are made good or accepted.
- 24. The value of Liquidated and Ascertained Damages will be £100.00 per calendar day.
- 25. **Insurances** are to be as follows:
 - a. The Employer will insure or otherwise underwrite the existing building
 - b. The Contractor shall hold £5m Contract Works Insurance cover
 - c. The Contractor shall hold £10m Public Liability Insurance cover
 - d. The Contractor shall hold £5m Professional Indemnity (design) Insurance cover.
- 26. The Employer's Nominee and Contractor's Nominee for notification and negotiation of disputes are TBC.
- 27. **Disputes** shall ultimately be settled by **Adjudication**. The adjudicators shall be **selected** by the RICS / RICS Dispute Resolution Service.
- 28. The Supplemental Provisions apply as follows:
- a. Health & Safety (safe culture promotion) applies
- b. Cost Saving and Value Improvements (shared savings) does not apply
- c. Performance Indicators and Monitoring (KPIs/rectification) does not apply.
- 29. The **Governing Law** shall be the law of **England and Wales**.
