General Notes on contract

1. Please do not cut grass in drought conditions

- 2. Please take care to avoid causing damage when strimming around wooden play equipment and **trees** (leave a 20cm / 8in border around base)
- 3. Please take care when strimming around residents' drain covers and downpipes/guttering to avoid damage.
- 4. In accordance with the Wildlife & Countryside Act 1981, when hedge cutting, please observe bird nesting season between1st March and 31st August and only cut hedges if they can be thoroughly checked for the absence of nesting birds.

Highways Maintenance of Grass Verges

The contract includes the cutting of some Gloucestershire County Council grass verges as shown in the Village Maintenance Map and these are included in the green highlighted areas.
