1	Pannell Drive	We are to remove the existing Multiplay, but are we to retain the existing fencing to house the toddler area or do you require all new fencing?	Please provide all new fencing.
2	Pannell Drive	Are we able to overlay existing surfacing?	We require all new surfacing and sub base designed to reflect the new play equipment
3	Corbett Road	Are you ideally looking for an in-ground roundabout or just a further inclusive option?	Our preference is an all inclusive roundabout option, but if this is unable to be achieved due to budget constraints, please provide an alternative option.
4	All	Is this a winner takes all project? If so are the budgets flexible across sites?	This would be acceptable, providing the overall budget is not exceeded and all sites meet the requirements and expectations of the brief.

We are not expecting the new 5-12 year old playpark to be fenced and we are expecting a new fence for the 0-5 year old area.
7	Pannell Drive	Should these two fenced areas be located next to each other, or is a distance between them preferred?	Please see above for clarification
8	Pannell Drive	Would you consider one larger, combined play area for 0–12-year-olds instead of two separate ones? This could create a more cohesive, flowing space and allow easier supervision for parents/carers with children of different ages.	We would not discount a combined play area if you were able to put together a strong case for this proposal but our preference is to have a separate fenced area for 0-5 year olds.
