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Introduction

This invitation to tender (ITT) has been prepared by Wendover Parish Council joined by Halton Parish Council. We are inviting proposals for the ongoing maintenance of streetlights and the changeover of existing lights to part night lighting. These are to be considered two separate tenders for two separate Parish Councils under the same terms and pricing schedule.

Wendover Parish Council maintains all lights off the main thoroughfares including some established side roads and relatively new housing estates. This totals c 580 lights. Halton Parish is a smaller neighbouring Parish with a limited number of streetlights totalling 53

This Invitation to Tender is subject to the following instructions.

Tender Instructions

1. Questions

Queries relating to this tender must be raised in writing no later than noon on 19th December 2025 and should be addressed to the Wendover Parish Council Clerk by email to clerk@wendover-pc.gov.uk

2. Site Visits

The Contractor is assumed to have visited the site to assess the nature of the work, access, topography etc and carried out relevant services/utilities checks. Should site visits be required with The Council then this should take place well in advance of the tender close date, contact clerk@wendover-pc.gov.uk and Clerk@halton-pc.gov.uk to arrange.

3. Insurance

The Contractor must have the following minimum insurance cover in place:

£10m Public Liability Insurance

£5m Employer's Liability Insurance

£1m Professional Indemnity Insurance

4. Deadline for receipt of tenders

All tenders must be secured submitted to the Clerk by email (clerk@Wendover-pc.gov.uk) by the return date specified in this tender pack (5th January 2026).

5. Supporting documents

Please note to be considered, tenders must include all the criteria listed below:

- Introductory letter and introduction to the company including company name, registration number, legal status, date of incorporation/registration, registered address, VAT number and any other relevant particulars.,
- Breakdown of fees charged
- Details of any relevant membership of professional bodies
- Outline service level agreement.
- Evidence of insurance cover for Public Liability, Employer's Liability and Professional Indemnity
- Health and Safety Policy

6. Business References

In addition to your tender, please include two business references obtained in the last 2 years. Please include the contact names and telephone numbers of referees.

7. The Decision

The process will involve presenting a proposal to the Clerk and then a decision being made in a single stage process at a Council meeting. The Council is not bound to accept the lowest priced, or any, tender.

8. Canvassing

Contractors tendering for this contract must not canvas Members of the Council or its Officers. Any effort to do so will immediately disqualify any tender submitted.

9. Notification of Outcome

The Clerk will notify all parties of the outcome of this tender process by email before noon on 5th Feb 2026.

10. Freedom of Information

Please note that all information submitted to the Council may need to be disclosed and/or published by the Parish Council. Specification of Works

1. The contractor will tender for the ongoing maintenance of Wendover Parish Council and Halton Parish Council Streetlights - based on previous years repair numbers and number of streetlights in usage (see appendix).

These works shall include a breakdown of the following costs:

- a) Costs to replace LED lantern or older lanterns with an ECO LED lantern
- b) Costs to replace the light sensor
- c) Costs to report a fault to UKPN
- d) Costs for an emergency same day call out to make a lantern safe
- e) Costs to replace a lantern
- f) Costs for a full inspection to assess the overall health and safety of all parish owned lights (which is normally undertaken every 5 years)

The company will need to invoice inspections, repairs and maintenance to the responsible Parish Council which shall be made clear at the reporting stage

2. We have a current project looking into part night lighting and there are works required that allow us to do this. We are currently looking at either turning off alternate lights or turning all lights off between 12 midnight and 5am.

We are currently aware of 2 ways we can turn off lights between 12 and 5am – The first being a change of the light sensor to a more “intelligent” sensor that can track time based on light levels and turn the lamp off. The other being to change the dimmer profile on our current LED unit.

The tender shall include a quote for this work, with any recommendations on the options set out.

3. Costs to replace current lanterns with heritage style fittings within the Halton Conservation Area (indicated in maps in appendices)

All costs will be specified to include labour, parts and materials

All works will include a minimum 12 month warranty

The ideal company

The chosen contractor should be registered to the highway electrical registration scheme 'HERS' <https://thehea.org.uk/>

The chosen contractor should also have ISO9001 and ISO45001 registration.

All works to conform to the following requirements:

British Standards (BS 5489-1:2020):

This standard provides guidelines for the design and installation of road lighting. The latest update reflects the shift towards using white light sources and includes considerations for sustainability and ecological impacts. It emphasizes the need for effective lighting design to enhance safety and visibility on roads.

Manual for Streets:

This document outlines principles for street design, including lighting. It emphasizes the importance of integrating street lighting into the overall design of residential areas to improve safety and community interaction. While it does not set new policy, it serves as a reference for best practices in street design, including lighting.

Local Government Act 1966:

This legislation grants local highway authorities the power to provide and maintain street lighting. It outlines the responsibilities of authorities regarding the installation and maintenance of lighting systems, ensuring that they meet safety and operational standards.

Guide to Highway Electrical Street Furniture:

This guide addresses the electrical safety considerations and requirements for street lighting and other electrical street furniture. It provides a comprehensive overview of the necessary precautions and standards that must be adhered to during installation and maintenance.

Price Evaluation

Price will be evaluated based on the lowest price Quotation achieving the maximum score (expressed as a percentage (%)) for the pricing element. Higher priced Quotations will receive a proportional score based on the amount higher they are than the lowest priced Quotation.

A worked example is set out below. In this example, the maximum available mark for price is 60%, the lowest price (3) is £425 and the higher price (5) is £625.

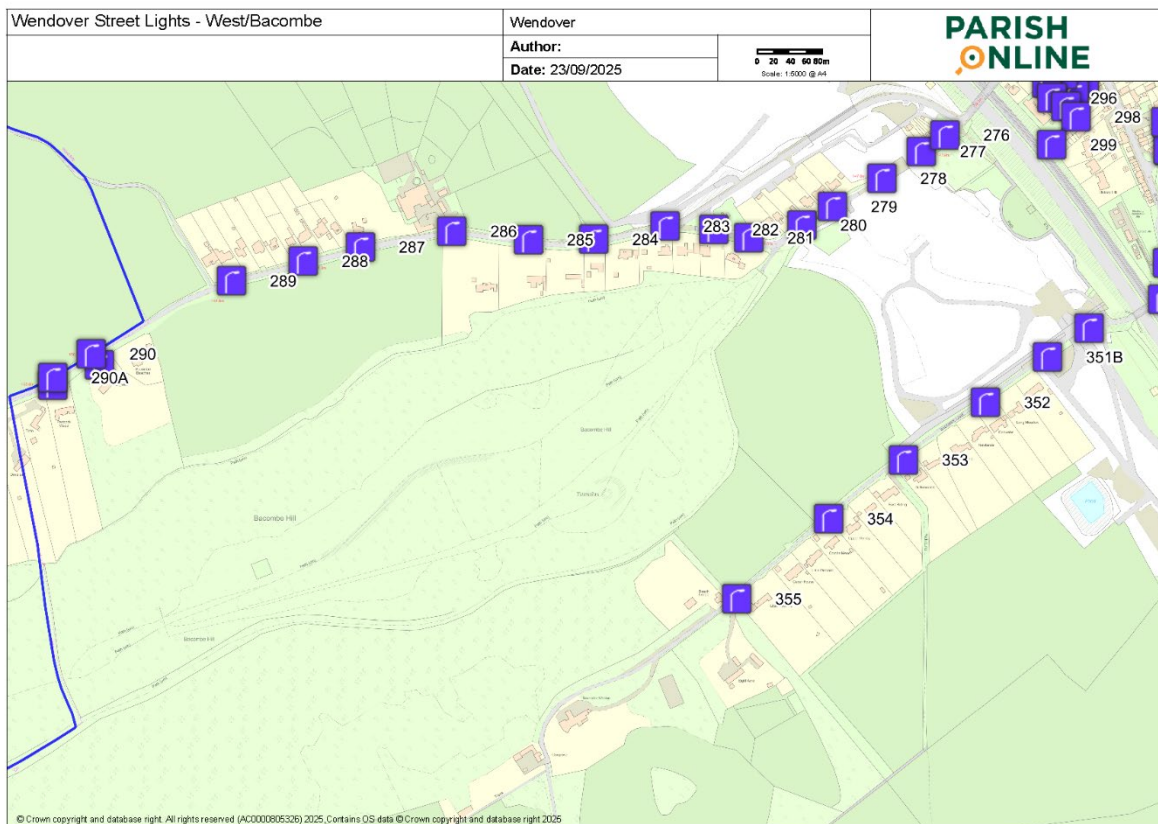

The maps below show the extent of our streetlights and the table identifies each individual lantern owned by .

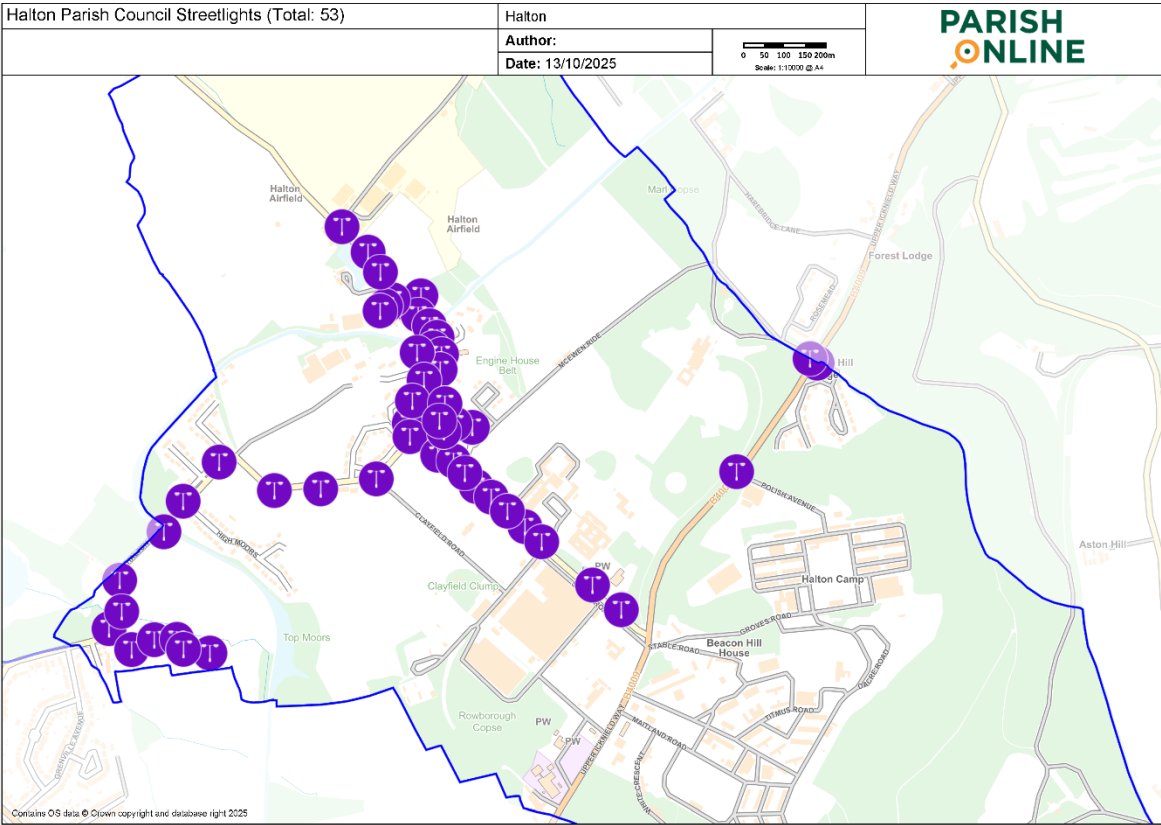
There are some lanterns not currently present due to the HS2 construction works that will be returned at full cost to HS2.
